The Japan Association of International Relations – General Incorporated Foundation –

Regulations Concerning the Establishment of Committees

Objectives

Article 1 These regulations are enacted for the purpose of aiding the administration of the general incorporated foundation of the Japan Association of International Relations (hereafter, the Association).

Standing Committees

Article 2 In order to promote the activities of the Association, in accordance with Article 46 of the Constitution of the Association, the following Standing Committees shall be created: Program Committee; Editorial Committee; English Journal Editorial Committee; Public Relations Committee; and International Exchange Committee.

Appointment and Terms of Service of Standing Committee Chairs

Article 3 Chairpersons of each Standing Committee shall be appointed from among the Board's members by the President and approved by the Board. The Chairperson's terms of service shall be the same as those of the Board members.

Delegation to and Terms of Service on Standing Committees

Article 4 The Members who make up the Standing Committees are delegated by the President on the recommendation of the Committee Chairperson and with the approval of the Board. The Members' terms of service shall be the same as those of the Board.

Program Committee

Article 5 The Program Committee shall be responsible for holding Conferences, Seminars and Lectures.

Editorial Committee

Article 6 The Editorial Committee shall be responsible for publishing books and journals. It shall have particular responsibility for the Japanese-language *Kokusai Seiji [International Politics] journals* and other publications in Japanese.

English Journal Editorial Committee

Article 7 The English Journal Editorial Committee shall be responsible for publishing English books and journals. It shall have particular responsibility for the English-language *International Relations of the Asia-Pacific (IRAP) journals* and other publications in English.

Public Relations Committee

Article 8 The Public Relations Committee shall be responsible for publishing books and journals. It shall have particular responsibility for publication of the newsletter and managing the Association's homepage.

International Exchange Committee

Article 9 The International Exchange Committee shall be responsible for the implementation of international academic exchange.

Special Committees

Article 10 In addition to the above committees, the Board is able to set up a Special Committee for the execution of specific functions. The appointment of the chairperson and delegation of members to a Special Committee is the same as for the Standing Committees. The terms of service of Chairpersons and Members are not permitted to extend beyond those held by the Board.

Supplementary Provision

The above regulations are in effect from 11 May 2013.
