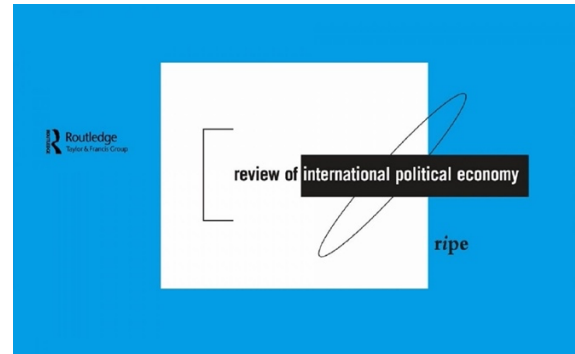

Call for Abstracts

IPE Pre-Convention Workshop

The **IPE Section**, with generous funding and support from *Review of International Political Economy*, will be hosting a workshop for **early career scholars** and **underrepresented voices in IPE** in advance of the ISA conference in Montreal, on Tuesday 14 March 2023.

The main goal of the workshop is to meet the needs of scholars who might otherwise have difficulties accessing the professional networks that tend to lead to professional opportunities and publications and/or whose perspectives are underrepresented in IPE, including early career researchers, scholars in the Global South, Black and indigenous scholars, those without tenure-track appointments, and those who challenge the conventional boundaries of IPE. The workshop gives participants an opportunity to meet with members of the *RIPE* editorial board and receive feedback on a manuscript they intend to submit to *RIPE* or another journal. Travel stipends will be provided to all participants. Workshop participants must be ISA members and registered for the 2023 Annual Convention. The workshop takes place at the convention venue in Montreal.

- An abstract of the paper you intend to present at the workshop (<250 words)
- A short biographical statement explaining how you and/or your work challenge the conventional boundaries of IPE (<250 words)
